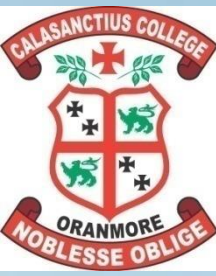
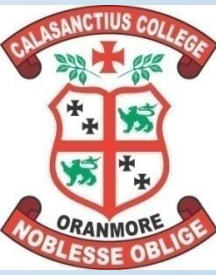

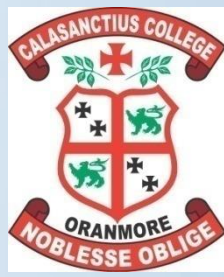
# LCVP



# To qualify to do LCVP

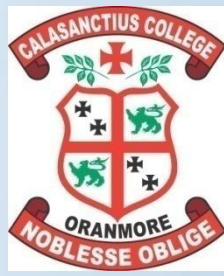
Students must take:

- A minimum of 5 Leaving Certificate subjects
- A continental language
- Irish (unless exempt)
- Two subjects from the following groupings



## Vocational Subject Groupings- Specified by the Department of Education

- Accounting, Business, Economics (**any two**)
- Art **and** Accounting **or** Art **and** Business **or** Art **and** Economics
- Biology **and** Chemistry **or** Biology **and** Physics
- Construction Studies **or** Design & Communication Graphics **and** Accounting **or** Business **or** Economics
- Construction Studies **or** Design & Communication Graphics **and** Physics
- Construction Studies **and** Design & Communication Graphics
- Home Economics **and** Accounting **or** Business **or** Economics
- Home Economics **and** Art
- Music **and** Accounting **or** Business **or** Economics
- Physics **and** Chemistry.
- Art **and** Design & Communication Graphics
- Ag. Science **and** Construction **or** DCG
- Ag. Science **and** Chemistry **or** Physics
- Home Economics, Ag. Science, Biology (any two)
- Ag. Science and Accounting or Business or Economics



# LCVP

## CAO Points available for LCVP

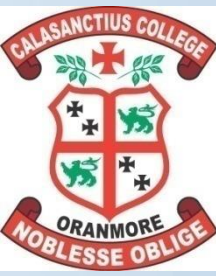
- Distinction (80-100%) 66 CAO points
- Merit (65-79%) 46 CAO points
- Pass(**50**-64%) 28 CAO points

Note:

H4 grade (60<70%) on a **Higher** level Leaving Certificate subject gets 66 CAO points- same as distinction on LCVP

O1 grade (90-100%) on an **Ordinary** level subject gets 56 CAO points, 46 points for O2 grade (80-90%)- same as a merit on LCVP

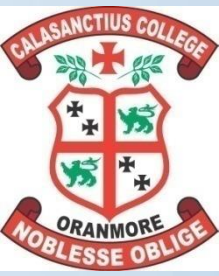
28 points is the same as an O4 grade (60-70%)

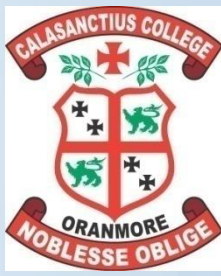

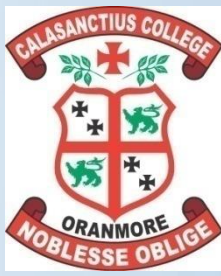

## Core Items

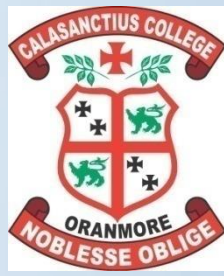
- Curriculum Vitae

## Optional Items

(Do 2 out of 4)

- **Recorded Interview**
- **Diary of Work Experience**
- Enterprise Report
- Report on “My Own Place”
